- **■**Construction and demolition material

■Garden vegetation ■Paper and cardboard ■Plastic ■Wood ■Glass bottles and jars ■Textiles e.g. clothing, carpets etc. ■Tyres ■Metals

Where possible each workshop will include a site tour and/or a presentation on resource recovery, recycling, waste management, etc.
