HELPING BUSINESS TO RECYCLE

A training workshop for Councils and the Waste/Recycling Collection Industry

Participants will be introduced to Bin Trim, a new EPA program designed to assist businesses to start wasting less and saving more. There will also be opportunity to talk with waste industry professionals and NSW EPA staff.

Learning outcomes

After attending this training session it is expected that participants will be able to:

- Assist a business to do a visual waste assessment using Bin Trim
- Assist a business to develop an action plan to reduce waste and increase recycling using Bin Trim
- Support a business to introduce new recycling services including advice on equipment, services and staff engagement
- Monitor and review progress being made by a business owner to reduce waste and increase recycling

The workshop content will cover information such as:

- Waste policy and resource recovery legislation
- The commercial & industrial waste stream
- Common resource recovery barriers and drivers for small and medium businesses
- Introduction to and training in the use of the Bin Trim tool
- Waste reduction and recycling for small to medium businesses
- Waste reduction and recycling options for each industry sector
- Waste reduction and recycling options for a variety of waste materials
- Best Practise Resource Recovery case studies
- An overview of how materials are recycled
- Support Resources including a copy of the Bin Trim tool and fact sheets

<u>Workshop material</u>: Each participant will be provided with a manual and Bin Trim resources to help you support your business customers to waste less and recycle more.

<u>Note</u>: Attendees are encouraged to bring their own laptop pre-loaded with Microsoft Excel (2003, 2007 or 2010). Please note that the Bin Trim Tool will not work on MAC hardware applications.
